

Your application documents for the ICV Controlling Excellence Award

Project presentation and supplementary documents: Two components of your application

Your complete application consists of two parts:

- 1. Project presentation: Please present your project to the Jury in a short and concise 10- to 15-page presentation (format: Powerpoint).
- 2. Additional documents: Please provide us with the following information about your company and your project (format: Word or Powerpoint).
 - Company information

Name, address, industry, size (turnover, number of employees).

Controlling area information:

Number of employees, design of central/decentralized controlling, organizational level

Management Summary of the project:

Project title, project objectives, brief description of the approach, duration of the project, key results.

Detailed project description:

Initial situation and motivation, project goals, resources used (financial resources and internal FTE, possibly integrated consulting capacities, etc.), conception, solution/implementation path, description of the results achieved (e.g. acceptance, number of users, efficiency and effectiveness gains, other improvements), implications for company success.

- Statements from two internal customers or users of the controlling solution
 Collecting answers to the question: "Please comment on the quality of the result
 and the creation process and describe what specific changes have occurred for
 you as a customer as a result of the new controlling solution. Are you satisfied
 with the creation process and the result?"
- Further steps

Information on the further development of the solution and/or follow-up steps as well as on using the most important findings from the project.

Please ensure that the Jury can get a complete and good picture of your project based on the project presentation and additional documents!

In addition to the PowerPoint and, if applicable, Word document, you can also include a short (homemade) video in your application package. However, there is no obligation to do so.

Irrespective of this, the Jury reserves the right to invite you for a supplementary online interview if necessary after studying the submitted documents and providing detailed advice.
